The Lorax (PreK-2nd)

Reading the Dr. Seuss classic with puppets and props to introduce children to the importance of conserving resources.

Superhero Sorters (K-2nd)

Let's talk recycling and look at the 3R's. Also introduces students to the 4th R! Recycling relay activity included.

NEW -- Freddy the Fish (K-5th)

Take an interactive journey with Freddy the Fish to explore how hazardous waste pollution affects water and wildlife.

Worms: Earth's Recyclers (2nd+)

A hands-on and "magnifying" look at worms & what they do for us. Optional: "How To" instructions on building a worm composting bin.

NEW -- An Oily Mess (2nd+)

Hands-on activity cleaning feathers teaches how oil spills affect us all.

Where Does Our Garbage Go? (2nd-5th)

A look at landfills & why we need to conserve. Ends with a sweet landfill model the children can eat! (Let educator know of any food allergies)

Musical Resources (2nd-5th)

A fun way to identify renewable and non-renewable resources. PLUS a game to introduce the concept of resource consumption

NEW -- Plastic, Plastic Everywhere! (2nd-5th)

Join a "clean-up crew" to see just how much plastic pollutes our environment. (Video shown)

E-Waste Not (3rd+)

What are the worldly effects of wanting and getting more of what we want in the Electronic Age? With a fun, active game that shows just how complicated it is to get a cell phone into your hands!

Garbology (4th+)

Learn how analyzing garbage can reveal information about a society and the impact that society makes on the environment.

(Check with educator on maximum group size and location)

Smart Consumers (5th+)

Helping students understand how the products they buy and use have an impact on our environment and others. **There are two versions of this class -- chocolate or clothing industry.**

(Let educator know of any food allergies/restrictions, Video shown)
