Public Compost Site Utility Person.

Will be required to have a physical presence and regular and reliable attendance. Will work mainly outdoors in all weather conditions. Directs the disposal of all Green waste materials from residential and commercial customers at the compost Site.

Job Requirements:

Be highly motivated and self-directed.

Must have experience driving, handling and maintaining heavy equipment. Valid Driver's License

Work hours are 37.5 per week with Saturdays required.

- Works as a full-time employee, operating the site as scheduled, which includes Saturdays and as the weather and seasons allow.
- Operates equipment related to the Compost Site such as a front-end loader, compost turner and dump truck, all used to maintain the Compost area.
- Possesses knowledge of current guidelines, acceptable disposal materials, and fees to charge for Compost Site use.
- Examines disposal loads for hazardous and toxic materials and/or materials that may damage equipment prior to dumping, and turns away unacceptable waste.
 Helps enforce applicable laws and policies against offenders who leave unauthorized materials.
- Knows and practices safe work habits. This includes appropriately observing safety standards, such as: Wearing hard hats, safety-toed shoes, protective eyewear, hearing protection, and other such gear.
- Working only in properly secured work areas.
 Assists other areas of the Solid Waste District when needed.
